



Once fully charged, make sure your Bluetooth function is turned on in your main device (ie. computer, laptop, tablet, or smartphone). Press the multifunction button (MFB-the flat side of both of the earbuds) on only one of the earbuds until the small LED light flashes red and blue signaling that the earbud is ready to pair.



After the first earbud is in pairing mode, press and hold the MFB on the second earbud for a brief few seconds until the red light come on (do not place second bud into pairing mode-only one of the earbuds needs to be placed into pairing mode). The second earbud will connect automatically with the first earbud.



Then go into your device's Bluetooth setting and tap on " MagicBeatz " (should only have one option in your mobile device). Enjoy your audio experience through MagicBeatz™!



To pause the audio/video file, simply press once on either earbud's MFB. To resume playing the audio/video file, simply press the MFB again. If playing an audio file (will work only for audio files, not video), you can skip to next song by double pressing the MFB button.

Recharging Earbuds: Carefully align the small recharging port on the back of both earbuds and insert the first earbud into protruding charging nozzle in docking base. Insert the other earbud in the same fashion into other charging nozzle in docking base. Both earbuds should be snugly plugged into the charging base. Charging process will be complete when the red light on charging buds turn blue. To recharge docking base, use the included cable and plug USB end to USB power adapter or computer and charge until LED on docking base turns blue, then unplug. To recharge your phone using the docking base, use the charging cable that came with your phone and plug the USB end into USB port on charging case and the charging process will begin. Unplug when full.

Answering calls:

- 1.If the incoming call is not from an unknown or Called ID blocked caller, the MagicBeatz™ earbud that was initially placed into pairing mode will recite the incoming phone number with area code one time to let you know of the incoming caller's phone number.
- 2.To answer the call, simply press on the MFB button once in the earbud that read off the incoming call phone number. The built-in mic will transmit your voice to the caller. To end the call, press the MFB button of that same earbud once.
- 3.To reject the call, press the MFB on the earbud that read off the incoming number twice.

Q/A Troubleshooting:

1.Can I use my earbuds as individual earbuds?

Yes, each earbud is designed to be able to function as individual buds if desired

2.What if I lose one of my earbuds, can I replace just the lost earbud?

No, because each pair of earbuds are specifically tuned to each other during production that they can't be paired with a different earbud, so you will need to purchase a new set

3.How much time do I have to enjoy my MagicBeatz™ earbuds before I have to recharge them?

MagicBeatz™ are equipped with industry leading battery capacity allowing user to enjoy them for a minimum of three hours

4.If my MagicBeatz™ need recharging, how long do I have to wait until I can enjoy my music again?

MagicBeatz™ will be recharged in approximately 1 hour

5.Can MagicBeatz™ be charged anywhere?

Yes, the MagicBeatz™ is a product that uses USB cable to recharge. So if you have a USB DC car adapter, power bank, or laptop computer with you, you can just about recharge your MagicBeatz™ anytime, anywhere

6.Having trouble connecting via Bluetooth to mobile device

Solution: Recharge the earbuds. Earbuds with low power will not successfully connect to any Bluetooth device

7.Music is cutting in and out

Solution: Recharge the earbuds. Earbuds with low power will start experiencing difficulty in staying paired thus the cutting of the Bluetooth signal. If earbuds are charged or have sufficient power, they will not cut out. If you're beyond 30ft or have too many walls between the earbuds and the source, move closer to the source or avoid the obstacles causing the interference.



Caution: Prolonged use of any enclosed audio listening device, ie. earbuds, earphones, or headphones, without proper resting periods in between listening sessions might result in temporary or permanent damage to inner ear and/or eardrum. Prolonged exposure to excessive volume will also likely result in similar eardrum damage. Take all precautionary measures to ensure that proper resting periods and proper listening volume is being used. Not recommended while driving.
